

PTC Meeting 02 November 2017

UPDATES:

- **FEST-OF-ALL:** was a big success thanks to everyone's hard work. The actual breakdown of the financials was published in the Parish bulletin from the weekend of 29 Oct. 2017
 1. Total profit earned was: \$90,000. This is split between the parish and the school SCJS was given \$45,000
 2. \$10,000 of the school's earnings will go toward the 5 year strategic plan
- **UNIFORMS:**
 1. The uniform committee has narrowed down their search to find a company that can provide quality and timely service at an affordable price. *Dennis Uniform Co.* will be the new uniform provider for the school. St. Mary's uses Dennis Uniform Co, and has had success with them
 2. A price list should be posted in January 2018
 3. Nothing is changing with the uniform in regard to styles, colors, etc.
- **STRATEGIC PLAN:** The process of completing the implementation schedule is going well. With the 7 main goals there are 80 strategies that need to be prioritized by year, and assigned accordingly. As soon as it is ready it will be published
 1. Parents will be able to get involved with implementation strategies
 2. The school board is scheduled to cycle out in January 2018. If you are interested in being on the board please submit your name to Mrs. Grooms
